Nicaragua

It's time to brush up your Spanish! This summer, our senior highs have the opportunity to travel to Nicaragua for a week of learning, work, and fellowship. Expert facilitators from our longtime mission partner, CEPAD, will lead our group to different sites around the country. You will be able to practice sustainable farming techniques, spend time with a Nicaraguan host family, learn about fair trade, and gain a deeper understanding of God's call to mission in your life.

When: June 17-24

Where: Managua (the capital), Matagalpa (the mountain city), CEPANA (CEPAD's beautiful teaching farm), and the village Las Delicias.

How Much: \$1000 all inclusive. Commitment and \$250 deposit required by April 1, balance to be paid April 30.

- Nicaragua is the safest country in Central America, and with CEPAD's facilitation we can feel totally secure.

- There will be two pre-trip meetings to talk about logistics and prepare spiritually for the trip.
